Thank you to all who helped out with the show and meeting and congratulations to all of the exhibitors and winners!

From the Desk of ... **John Ford**,

SGBI Executive Director

It's summer and the 2018 National Junior Santa Gertrudis Show will take place June 23rd – 30th at the Four States Fairground in Texarkana, Arkansas. The annual event is the highlight of the year for approximately 300 young Santa Gertrudis cattle enthusiasts and their families. Attending and visiting with our association's junior members is also one of the highlights of my year and I am always impressed by these young people's communication and leadership skills. However, I think that one of the greatest values of the junior program is that it promotes family time and the opportunity for a family to

work together. Walking the aisles, it is not unusual to find families that have been participating in junior Santa Gertrudis events for 3 generations. I am convinced that families passionate about the National Junior Santa Gertrudis Show are also passionate about the long-term viability and future of the breed.

However, I realize demographics are changing. Fewer and fewer junior families live on a farm or ranch and even fewer depend on livestock production for their livelihood. I suspect the majority of junior show participants maintain their projects on small acreage around their home or at a FFA/4-H Ag Facility. More than likely, participating in the National Junior Show is one of the few links that connects juniors and their family members to the beef industry. In today's world, young people wishing to pursue farming or ranching as a livelihood face countless barriers. Acquiring land resources and financing combined with the challenges of becoming established are only a few of the difficulties faced. Unfortunately, for many junior members circumstances dictate that following their tenure in the youth program association, membership ends.

As an association we must always be looking to the future, aware of the changing demographics. Junior program success requires a continuous focus on strengthening junior activities. We must insure that participants have the tools needed to move into the ranks of active SGBI membership. Earlier this year, the SGBI Youth Activities Committee formed a partnership with Texas A&M University Kingsville in order to develop a long-range junior programming strategic plan. Once completed the plan will serve as a road map, provid-

ing the YAC and association leadership with the information needed to grow the junior program in today's changing world and transition more juniors into the active membership ranks. Few would disagree, the National Junior Santa Gertrudis Association is one of the best junior livestock programs in the nation. By taking this proactive approach with the development of a long-range plan, SGBI will continue to build on the strong foundation laid during the first National Junior Santa Gertrudis Show over 40+ years ago.

Dear Santa Gertrudis Breeder.

The 2018 Cattleman's Opportunity Sale, hosted by the Mid-Coast Santa Gertrudis Association, will be held Saturday, September 15, 2018 at 11 a.m. at the Lavaca Exposition Center, Hallettsville, TX. This sale is open to consignment by all Mid-Coast members. If you are not a member, we invite you to join and bring your best to Hallettsville. Visit https://midcoastsantagertrudis.com/ for a membership application or to join online.

Below are the sale rules and screening standards to assist you in selecting your lots. Please contact Sale Chairman Matt Kubena at (979) 373-1911 or makubena@aol.com with any questions.

***ALL CATTLE CONSIGNED WILL BE SCREENED PRIOR TO SALE DATE.

- Pen lots of three head or less will be accepted.
- All cattle must be registered purebred Santa Gertrudis or Santa Gertrudis Star Five. (Consignors must be in good standing with SGBI).
- 3. Females must be between the ages of 6 months through 6 years old (females must not be 7 years old the day of the sale).
- 4. Bulls 15 to 48 months of age are eligible. ***ALL BULLS MUST BE GAIN TESTED
- 5. Bulls must have a sheath score of 3 or less.
- 6. Embryo, flushes, donor cows, bred recipient cows and semen lots will be accepted.
- Fertility A licensed veterinarian must certify the following;
 - Females over 26 months of age must calve by 36 months of age
 - Females with a calf at side that is 6 months of age or older must be safe in calf
 - Females with a calf at side that is 9 months of age or older must be safe in calf in at least the second trimester.
 - Bulls, 15 months and older, must be fertility tested and confirmed a satisfactory breeder within 30 days of the sale and Trich tested according to Texas Animal Health Commission rules

Other Considerations:

- Females with a calf under 6 months of age may sell open or exposed
- Females over the age of 4 must have a calving interval noted on the consignment form
- Cattle must be sound, functional, and in good flesh. Any cattle falling under the SGBI "Standards of Excellence" will not be allowed to sell.

 "Disqualifications" section of the
- Cattle must have a health certificate allowing interstate shipment and showing fertility results (if applicable), issued within 30 days of sale date. Check with your veterinarian for any additional health requirements such as Brucellosis testing of cows over 18 months of age, TB testing etc.

Any animal not meeting these requirements will be automatically removed from the sale offering.

The non-refundable consignment fee is \$100.00 per lot or per pen. Commission will be 10%. (\$40.00 of consignment fee will be credited towards commission).


