From the Desk of ... John Ford, SGBI Executive Director

Discussing herd goals and assisting membership with the development of long-term breeding objectives is one of the most enjoyable aspects of my job. I always begin these discussions with the following question; "Who is your customer, who do you want to sell cattle to?" I don't believe herd goals can be set without knowing who the targeted customer is and how you best market your genetic package to that audience. For long-term success, seedstock producers must have a plan that includes developing a breeding goal which matches an identified set of cattle buyers.

The genetic needs of our Santa Gertrudis buying customers varies and a "one-size fits all" approach to marketing is not an effective strategy in today's competitive data driven beef industry. The genetic needs of a customer operating on an improved East Texas pasture are probably different than a buyer whose operation is in the desert Southwest. A young person looking to purchase one show heifer has a selection yardstick that is very distinct and does not mirror that of a cowman needing 150 replacement females to make cows that produce calves for a terminal market. Profitable cattle marketing involves more than just getting the highest price. It centers on producing the type of animal the targeted market desires and marketing through the best outlet and at the best time. Marketing seedstock requires decisions be made about how or what genetic package is to be produced and where to market and when to price. After all, there will not be very many commercial bull buyers in the seats of a sale marketing 30 lots of haltered show heifers. And it is also a safe bet there will not be many junior showmen found in the bleachers of a 200 head bull and commercial female sale hoping to spot their next NJSGA project animal.

As a breed, are we doing a good job marketing our genetics? In some instances, we are doing an acceptable job, but I believe we can and must do better. The beef industry is becoming more and more technology driven, utilizing reproductive management strategies, genetic improvement technologies, and other cutting-edge practices focused on increasing efficiency and reducing the cost of production. Evolving consumer demographics and the globalization of beef markets have also dictated changes in the types of products that consumers are demanding. The complexity of today's seedstock sector necessitates SGBI members, affiliates and leadership to examine the effectiveness of the breed's marketing efforts.

Yancey Strait, SGBI past president, will moderate a roundtable discussion focused on marketing issues and opportunities during the 2019 Annual Membership Meeting. This marketing session is scheduled for Friday, April 12, 2019, 1:00 – 3:00, Hyatt Regency Riverwalk in San Antonio, Texas. In order to capture the greatest amount

of market share we must have a serious conversation about how we offer our genetic package to a diverse and complex beef industry. As marketers of Santa Gertrudis genetics, we must recognize the industry has changed and continues to change, and these changes impact how seedstock is marketed. Please mark your calendar for this important discussion that will serve as a starting point for evaluating how Santa Gertrudis genetics are sold. I hope to see you there.

Below are the sale rules and screening standards to assist you in selecting your lots. Please contact Sale Chairman Matt Kubena at (979) 373-1911 or makubena@aol.com with any questions.

***ALL CATTLE CONSIGNED WILL BE SCREENED PRIOR TO SALE DATE.

- Pen lots of three head or less will be accepted.
- 2. All cattle must be registered purebred Santa Gertrudis or Santa Gertrudis Star Five. (Consignors must be in good standing with SGBI).
- 3. Females must be between the ages of 6 months through 6 years old (females must not be 7 years old the day of
- 4. Bulls 15 to 48 months of age are eligible. ***ALL BULLS MUST BE GAIN TESTED
- 5. Bulls must have a sheath score of 3 or less.
- Embryo, flushes, donor cows, bred recipient cows and semen lots will be accepted.
 Fertility A licensed veterinarian must certify the following:
- - Females over 26 months of age must calve by 36 months of age
 - Females with a calf at side that is 6 months of age or older must be safe in calf
 - Females with a calf at side that is 9 months of age or older must be safe in calf in at least the
 - Bulls, 15 months and older, must be fertility tested and confirmed a satisfactory breeder within 30 days of the sale and Trich tested according to Texas Animal Health Commission

Other Considerations:

- Females with a calf under 6 months of age may sell open or exposed
- · Any female 4 years old or older needs to have calving interval included
- 8. Cattle must be sound, functional, and in good flesh. Any cattle falling under the "Disqualifications" section of the SGBI "Standards of Excellence" will not be allowed to sell.
- 9. Cattle must have a health certificate allowing interstate shipment and showing fertility results (if applicable), issued within 30 days of sale date. Check with your veterinarian for any additional health requirements such as Brucellosis testing of cows over 18 months of age, TB testing etc.

Any animal not meeting these requirements will be automatically removed from the sale offering.

The non-refundable consignment fee is \$100.00 per lot or per pen, due at the time you submit your paperwork. Commission will be 10%. (\$40.00 of consignment fee will be credited towards commission).


