The 2020 Cattleman's Opportunity Sale, hosted by the Mid-Coast Santa Gertrudis Association, will be held **Saturday, May 9, 2020 at 12 p.m.** at the **Washington County Fairgrounds Sales Facility**, **Brenham, TX.** This sale is open to consignment by all Mid-Coast members. If you are not a member, we invite you to join and bring your best to Brenham. Visit https://midcoastsantagertrudis.com/ for a membership application or to join online.

Below are the sale rules and screening standards to assist you in selecting your lots. Please contact Sale Chairman Matt Kubena at (979) 373-1911 or <u>makubena@aol.com</u> with any questions.

***ALL CATTLE CONSIGNED WILL BE SCREENED PRIOR TO SALE DATE.

- 1. Pen lots of three head or less will be accepted.
- 2. All cattle must be registered purebred Santa Gertrudis or Santa Gertrudis Star Five. (Consignors must be in good standing with SGBI).
- 3. Females must be between the ages of 6 months through 6 years old (females must not be 7 years old the day of the sale).
- 4. Bulls 15 to 48 months of age are eligible. ***ALL BULLS MUST BE GAIN TESTED
- 5. Bulls must have a sheath score of 3 or less.
- 6. Embryo, flushes, donor cows, bred recipient cows and semen lots will be accepted.
- 7. Fertility <u>A licensed veterinarian must certify the following;</u>
 - Females over 26 months of age must calve by 36 months of age
 - Females with a calf at side that is 6 months of age or older must be safe in calf
 - Females with a calf at side that is 9 months of age or older must be safe in calf in at least the second trimester
 - Bulls, 15 months and older, must be fertility tested and confirmed a satisfactory breeder within 30 days of the sale and Trich tested according to Texas Animal Health Commission rules

Other Considerations:

- Females with a calf under 6 months of age may sell open or exposed
- Any female 4 years old or older needs to have calving interval included
- 8. Cattle must be sound, functional, and in good flesh. Any cattle falling under the **"Disqualifications"** section of the SGBI "Standards of Excellence" will not be allowed to sell.
- Cattle must have a health certificate allowing interstate shipment and showing fertility results (if applicable), issued within 30 days of sale date. <u>Check with your veterinarian for any</u> <u>additional health requirements such as Brucellosis testing of cows over 18 months of age, TB testing etc.</u>

Any animal not meeting these requirements will be automatically removed from the sale offering.

The non-refundable consignment fee is \$100.00 per lot or per pen, due at the time you submit your paperwork. Commission will be 10%.
