

Mid-Coast Santa Gertrudis Association Scholarship

Eligibility

- Active (Paid) Junior Mid Coast member in good standing as of March 15, 2020
- Must be a high school graduating senior
- Must have made a formal application to enroll in a college or university
- During awarded period must maintain 2.5 GPA or higher and completed a minimum of 12 semester credit hours a semester, preferably 15 semester credit hours.

Application

- Application (Use additional sheets if needed) HANDWRITTEN in applicant's hand
 - One-page personal narrative HANDWRITTEN in applicant's hand or typed in Times New Roman (12 point). I.E., write a narrative, no more than one page, about yourself pointing out any important facts you would like the selection committee to know. Do not repeat information already stated in application.
- Use college-ruled notebook paper.

Payment

- Funds raised and Mid-Coast Board of Directors will determine amount.
- First payment will be made upon proof of enrollment of a minimum of 12 semester credit hours (i.e., class schedule or fee slip with name of educational institution) by September 1 or when proof of enrollment is received.
- Second payment will be made second semester upon proof of enrollment of a minimum of 12 semester credit hours and official grade report demonstrating successful completion of a minimum of 12 semester credit hours with name of educational institution by January 1 of school year for which scholarship is granted. In the event the recipient fails to maintain a 2.5 or better GPA during the first semester and/or maintain 12 semester credit hours, the second installment will be forfeited.

- High school GPA
- Consideration of activities and leadership in:
 1. Mid-Coast Santa Gertrudis Junior Organization and other Santa Gertrudis organizations and activities
 2. FFA or 4-H activities
 3. High School, community, and Church activities
- Financial Need
- Letter of Recommendation
- Eligibility criterion stated above
- Completed application
